MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING

November 22, 2004

An open and public hearing, posted pursuant to the open meetings law, was held on Monday, November 22, 2004, at 6:30 pm in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Derrick McElwaney, Mayor Pro-Tem; Clay Cole, Council Member; Stan Parten, Council Member; Robin Spradlin, Town Clerk; Donna Camp, Assistant Town Clerk.

Also in attendance were Raymond Sinkfield, Keith and Cynthia Rhodes, Celene Davenport and Sgt. Crook of Coweta County Sheriffs Department.

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public input and comments on making Sunset Drive a one-way road.

The Mayor Pro-Tem opened the meeting by welcoming the citizens in attendance and explaining the purpose of the meeting.

The Mayor asked the public and Council for comments. Celene Davenport's suggestion was to make Sunset Drive an exit only onto Highway 54 and use Williams Circle for the entrance. This would allow the children getting off/on school buses to keep from having to pass in front of the bus when loading and unloading.

There was no other public comments and no official action was taken and the Public Hearing was adjourned.
