

TOWN OF SHARPSBURG
MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING

April 10, 2006

An open and public hearing, posted pursuant to the open meetings law, was held on Monday, April 10, 2006, at 7:00 pm in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Derrick McElwaney, Mayor Pro-Tem; Larry Hyde, Council Member; Robin Spradlin, Town Administrator; Donna Camp, Town Clerk. Mayor Staley and Council Member Cole were absent.

Public present were the following: Marilyn Hall and Bobby Sills, Hall Planning; Polly Garlington.

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public input and comments on the proposed Comprehensive Plan and Capital Improvements Program which is to be submitted to the Chattahoochee-Flint Regional Development Center and Department of Community Affairs for review.

The Mayor Pro-Tem opened the meeting by welcoming the citizens in attendance and introduced Marilyn Hall and Bobby Sills of Hall Planning. Marilyn Hall distributed copies of the Community Participation Program, Community Assessment and the Technical Addendum and explained the process and timeline of the Comprehensive Plan Update. Bobby Sills gave an overview of the process and timeline of the Capital Improvements Program and the Capital Improvements Element.

The Mayor Pro-Tem asked the public and Council for comments – there were none.

There was no official action taken and the Public Hearing was adjourned.
