## TOWN OF SHARPSBURG MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

## December 17, 2007

A regular meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, December 17, 2007, at 6:30pm, in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Wendell Staley, Mayor; Clay Cole, Council Member; Stan Parten, Council Member; Derrick McElwaney, Council Member and Donna Camp, Town Clerk. Council Member Hyde was absent.

Mayor Staley called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

The pledge of allegiance was recited.

The Town Clerk verified there was a quorum present.

Public Hearing - 2008 General Fund & SPLOST Budgets - See Public Hearing Minutes

Mayor Staley called for a motion to close the Public Hearing. Council Member McElwaney motioned to close the Public Hearing, Council Member Cole seconded. Motion carried with a show of hands, unanimously.

The minutes of the Council Meeting held on November 19, 2007 were reviewed and approved.

Mayor Staley called for a motion to approve a resolution to adopt the 2008 General and SPLOST fund budgets. Council Member Parten motioned to adopt 2008 budgets with the inclusion of a line item added for the Tree Board to the General Fund Budget. Council Member McElwaney seconded. Motion carried by show of hands, unanimously.

Mayor Staley polled the Council for comments – Council Member McElwaney presented the outgoing Mayor and Council Members with plaques and thanking them for the service to the Town of Sharpsburg.

Mayor's Minutes - The Mayor thanked everyone for the privilege of serving as Mayor and advised the incoming Council Members and Mayor-Elect that there was still lots of work left to do and hoped what they started will be continued.
