A work session of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, August 16, 2010, at 12:30pm, at the A&O Bridges Recreation Center.

The Town Clerk verified there was a quorum present.

Main Street Park -

- > Rotate the gazebo and pavilion 90 degrees
- ➢ Lighting
- Insurance
- > Maintenance
- Sprinkler system
- Security

Recreation Center Renovations -

- > Bricks to match sidewalks
- > Move water heater
- Heat pump vs. gas (Fuel Mechanical Newnan, EMC, Blossman)
- > 3 phase panel
- Microphones, jacks and wiring

Extra parking -

- Monthly fee basis
- Negotiating fee of \$300/month
- Tree removal
- Insurance
- ➢ Lighting
- Storage building lease/buy storage container (Ann Long)

Stovall Street Paving -

- Coweta County is doing the engineering
- > 12' of concrete based paving
- > Road will need to be moved due to barn in right of way

Water/Sewer -

- Decentralized sewer would cost \$350,000 +/- for Terrentine Road, Main Street and the Hwy 54/154 crossing.
- > Getting proposals for grant writing for the CDBG grant to fund sewer
- > The town waterlines in need of replacement
- > Talking with Town of Turin to get waterlines replaced
- > Coweta County would replace all waterlines and provide water service to old Town

Highway 54 Loan Renewal -

- One-year renewal at 5% interest
- ➢ Balance on loan \$76,546
- Balance on CD \$77,000 currently getting 1.23% interest
- > Possible to pay off loan with CD and put remainder in General Fund

Grants –

- > Town looking into several different grants
- > Engineering work needs to be completed before applying for any grants
- NFL Grant fund sports complex
- CDBG Water/Sewer
- Gateway GDOT Town entrance landscaping and signage
- > TE Grant GDOT Transportation enhancement sidewalk

City of Ethics -

> Town would like to apply for the ethics designation
