

**TOWN OF SHARPSBURG  
MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

**December 5, 2011**

A regular scheduled meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, December 5, 2011, at 7:00pm, in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Sharpsburg Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Wendell Staley, Mayor; Connie Turner, Council Member; Celene Davenport, Council Member. Council Members Anderson, Rhodes and Clerk Camp were absent.

Also in attendance were: Gwen Lyons, Dylan Davenport and Polly Garlington.

Mayor Staley called the December meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was delivered.

The Mayor verified there was a quorum present.

The minutes of the October 24<sup>th</sup>, November 7<sup>th</sup> and November 28, 2011 Council Meetings were reviewed and approved as written by unanimous vote, and were filed in the minute book of the Town.

Mayor Staley hoped that everyone in attendance would be able to attend the Christmas Dinner that will be on December 19<sup>th</sup> at 7pm.

Mayor Staley called for a motion to allow the merchants to put Christmas lights on the light poles downtown. Council Member Davenport motioned, Council Member Turner seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

  - The Coweta County School bus is letting 6 children cross Hwy 54 when they get off the bus. Three on Williams Circle and three on Sunset Drive. Dylan Davenport stated that the bus driver said that the bus couldn't get down Sunset Drive because of the tree limbs

Mayor's Minutes -

- The intersection at Hwy 154 and Old Hwy 16 is scheduled to get raised markers to raise attention until the road work can be completed in the future.
- We have received a complaint about the house on the corner of Terrentine Road and Hwy 154 and it being utilized as a multi-family unit when it is under a single family zoning. When the current zoning ordinance was adopted the house was being used as a multi-family unit which makes it a non-conforming house. The house will have to be empty for 6 months or more before it will revert to the new zoning. The six month period won't be over until the first of February. The house is currently being rented out to a family
