

**TOWN OF SHARPSBURG
MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

February 6, 2017

A regular scheduled meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, February 6, 2017, at 6:00pm, at the Sharpsburg Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Wendell Staley, Mayor; Stan Parten, Council Member; Clay Cole, Council Member; Polly Garlington, Council Member; Donna Camp, Town Clerk. Council Member Rhodes was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was delivered.

The Clerk verified there was a quorum present.

Mayor Staley called to order the public hearing for the Environmental Control Ordinance Amendment concerning open burning. Mayor Staley discussed the amendment and called for any comments.

Mayor Staley called for a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Council Member Parten motioned to adjourn, Council Member Garlington seconded. Motion carried, unanimously.

The minutes of the January 23, 2017 Council Meeting were reviewed and approved by unanimous vote, and were filed in the minute book of the Town.

Mayor Staley called for first reading of Environmental Control Ordinance Amendment concerning open burning. Copies of ordinance were previously presented to Council and were available for inspection by public. Council Member Garlington motioned to accept the ordinance for first reading. Council Member Parten seconded. Motion carried, unanimously. Second reading and adoption scheduled for the March 6, 2017 meeting of Council.
